Dear Sir:-

As I wrote the Corbin people a few days ago, I wish you would see that they stop the rattling on the Right rear wheel. This is very annoying and before you accept delivery you must see that this noise has stopped.

Also see that they put two new mud guards on the front and fix the steering gear. We also want a new rubber mat for the front and a new celluloid front for the top, also a new tail lamp.

While they have the car apart, you might see if ^{they} you cannot adjust the gearing, so that when you shift the gears the grinding sound will be obviated. I think if the gears were properly in line, when you shift them you would not have so much noise.

Take these matters up with the factory and have them attended to. Keep this letter and see that all matters are taken care of properly before you accept the car.
